

Page County Democratic Caucus to Elect Delegates

The Democratic Party of Page County, Virginia, (DPPCV) will have a virtual caucus from April 18th, 2020 at 12:00PM until April 20th, 2020 at 7:00PM to select 4 delegates and 1 alternate to participate in the 6th Congressional District Nominating Convention on May 9 in Lexington, and the Virginia State Convention on June 20 in Richmond.

It is highly likely that both conventions will be conducted as virtual meetings and so there may not be a need for any delegate to travel.

The responsibilities of delegates at the conventions are simple:

- To elect national delegates to represent Virginia at the Democratic National Convention scheduled for July 13-16 in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
- Beyond that, there may be a few routine items (approving the agenda, approving the rules for the convention, hearing committee reports, etc.).

Dennis Kohanek, Chair of the DPPCV (who is also the Chair of PCDC) has appointed Clyde Humphrey to plan and chair the caucus and Sandra Schaberl as secretary of the caucus.

At the March 3rd primary in Page County, Joe Biden received 52.30% of the votes, Bernie Sanders received 24.53%, and no other candidate received more than 15%. Therefore the caucus will select 3 delegates and 1 alternate that are committed to support Joe Biden on the first ballot of both conventions and 1 delegate (and no alternates) to support Bernie Sanders.

Please note that the Democratic Party of Virginia (DPVA) has announced that if one locality has fewer people file to be elected than the number of delegates allowed, then the unused spaces may be allocated to other localities. This means that if we have more than five people file we may get more seats at the conventions. SO LETS ENCOURAGE LOTS OF OUR PEOPLE TO FILE TO BE ELECTED AS DELEGATES.

To file to stand for election as a delegate you must complete the online form.
